2008 - LCU

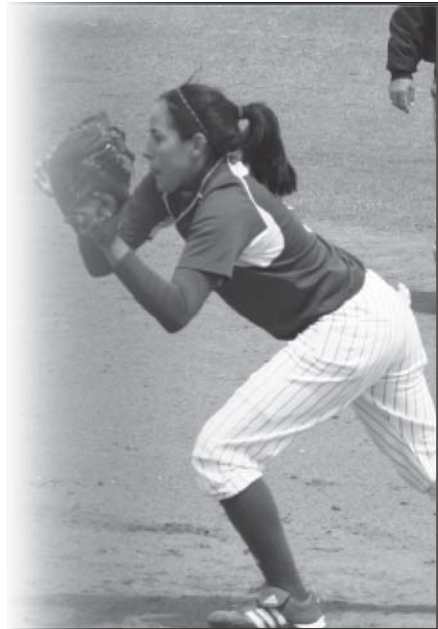

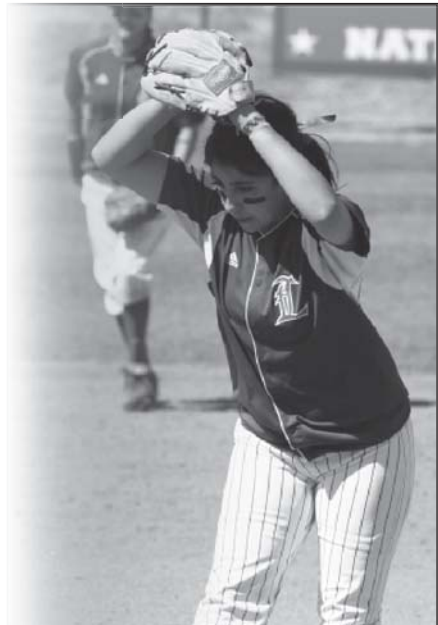

Tore a knee ligament and ended up on a medical redshirt, missing the entire season.

At Cypress College ... A two-time JUCO All-American at Cypress College, Gutierrez received Easton-Bell Junior College All-American honors in 2006 as a freshman after earning the win in the State Championship game. She was the CCCSCA South Pitcher of the Year in 2007 and was selected as a NFCA All-American. She holds the Cypress single-season strikeout record (235 in 2007) and also had the second best single-season ERA mark that same season (0.33). Gutierrez also left Cypress as the programs career batting leader (.418) and ranks second in hits (157) and fifth in RBI (91) and homers (9).

In High School ... A four-year standout, Gutierrez was honored as Female Athlete of the Year at La Mirada High School, which is the same high school Jennie Finch attended. Gutierrez led her high school to four consecutive Suburban League Championships earning First Team All-League mention for three seasons and league MVP for two seasons. Gutierrez also led her team to two CIF Division III runner-up finishes. She was awarded first team All-CIF twice and second team All-CIF once.

In 2005, she batted .349 with ten doubles and two homers on a squad that was the state runner-up. She claimed conference Player of the Year honors in 2006 batting .431 with 11 doubles, eight homers and 60 RBI. Clarissa also received All-State First Team honors. Played for legendary coach Mark Eldridge, who retired with over 1,000 wins following the 2006 season.

Last season saw Rodgers compete as a true freshman in the circle for the Lady Chaps ... she appeared in 29 games on the year with two of those in a starting role ... she led the team with a pair of saves on the season and in 50.1 innings of work she managed a 2.50 ERA ... she was 3-1 overall and tossed one complete game for the season ... she had 38 strikeouts and allowed 47 hits ... Rodgers also hit .357 with seven runs batted in on the year ... she had 14 at-bats and scored four runs, while also coming up with three doubles.

In High School

Jori finished her career at Coronado High School under head coach J.J. Johnson claiming consecutive All-State honors. Over her final high school season, she set nearly every Coronado pitching record, going 27-3 with 12 shutouts, an 0.61 ERA and 298 strikeouts. Her 27 wins was a new school record and surpassed her own record of 26 from 2007, which broke her sister's (Jacki) record from 2004. She also batted .427 with 7 home runs and 37 RBI. She claimed the Lubbock Avalanche-Journal's All-City Player of the Year award. As a junior, Jori posted a 26-5 record in the circle. Her performance not only helped earn First-Team All-State honors, but she also claimed Second-Team All-State honors by the Texas Sportswriters Association. Rodgers also contributed 13 wins on the mound as a sophomore while spending most of the season playing in centerfield. She knocked in 31 runs her sophomore year to earn First-Team All-District 2-5A accolades. Rodgers heads into her senior season this year holding the Mustangs record for strikeouts, and as a three-time All-Academic selection (05,06,07).
